**Warmup Time**

10 minutes (first match), then 2-2, 1 minute **shared** serving

**Officiating**

An adult must be up official

Use of personal electronic devices by members of the officiating team (R1, R2, line judges, score table) is **not** allowed

**Tournament format is pool play, followed by bracket play for all teams**

**Bracket position** will be determined by:

1. Set record (won/lost percentage)
2. Head-to-head results
3. Total points (+/-)
4. Coin toss

**Officiating:** First referee must be a coach. The designated officiating team must provide a score keeper, score board operator and two line judges. *Failure to provide an officiating crew for your assigned matches will result in a forfeit of the first set of your next match.*

**Gym will open at 7:20 a.m. Mandatory Coaches' Meeting at 7:40 AM** in the main gym on Court 1.

**Schedules:** Schedules will be posted on all score tables and a Master Schedule will be posted in the commons near the concession stand. Any necessary changes will be communicated at the coaches' meeting and throughout the day. Please see program co-directors Tracey Weaver or Janis Goehner with any questions.

**Pool Play Format:** **Two sets** to 25 points, win by 2, no cap. No 3<sup>rd</sup> set.

Unlimited service rule, with the serve behind the end line for over-hand servers, and 23' foot line for underhand servers.

- All matches will be played on the lower net using lite volleyballs.
- Liberos may serve.

**Warm-ups:** There will be a 10 minute warm-up for match 1 and 2, and 2-2-1 thereafter.

\* Please bring your own warm-up volleyballs.

**Playoffs:** All teams will advance to **Bracket Play**, with teams advancing to the gold, silver, bronze or red division. All matches in playoffs are 25, 25, 15 format. Best 2/3, no cap. After your pool is completed, please go immediately to your playoff court. T-shirts will be awarded to teams who place 1<sup>st</sup> in their divisions.

**Food and Beverages:** Concessions will be available at Lakeville North High School only. Outside food not permitted at Lakeville North High School. **ABSOLUTELY NO** food or beverages are allowed in any of the gyms. Please use the designated areas and pick up after yourself.
